HERE ARE SOME FACTS:

The sector's nurseries have produced an average of 13 million plants each year and are still growing;

Today, Portugal's woodlands cover nearly 40% of the country, thanks in good part to the pulp and paper industry, committed to sustainable management of its forestry holdings.

Ownership of Portugal's forests is divided between more than 400,000 landowners, most of them smallholders, and the forestry sector employs around 100,000 people;

Today, 70% of the energy used in the Portuguese pulp and paper industry is green, well above the European average of 56%, thanks to Portugal being one of the leading investors in forest biomass, a renewable resource.

In 2010, the Portuguese paper industry accounted for nearly 60% of office paper exports from Europe to the rest of the world.
